PUBLICATIONS

France A new edition of **Le Milieu divin** has just been published by Éditions Loyola, an imprint of Éditions du Cerf. It is of great interest because the text of this major work is introduced, commented on, and annotated by leading Teilhardian scholars. The original text was written in China in 1926–1927, then revised up to 1932 in order to satisfy ecclesiastical censors, though final permission to publish was never granted. What Jeanne Mortier published in 1957 is a composite of the different versions, all of which are clearly identified in the new edition. Pierre Teilhard de Chardin, Claude Tresmontant – Unpublished Correspondence, edited by **Emmanuel Tresmontant and Mercè Prats**, about to be published by Arcades Ambo. This volume

contains twelve letters written by Fr Teilhard toward the end of his life to the young Claude Tresmontant (1925–1997), a French philosopher. These letters are published here for the first time. ACCESS TO TEILHARD'S WORKS

With reference to the new edition of *Le Milieu divin* here is what Teilhard writes at the end of his introduction to *The Christic* (March 1955, Vol XIII):

It is already a long time since, in response to these new ways of seeing things, still barely defined in my mind, I tried, in The Mass on the World and Le Milieu Divin, to give distinct expression to my sense of wonder and amazement.

Today, after forty years of continuous thought, it is still exactly the same fundamental vision that I feel I must present, and enable others to share in its matured form—for the last time.

It may not be expressed with the same freshness and exuberance as resulted from my first meeting with it, but the wonder and the passion will still be there, undimmed.
