RD Congo **The Teilhard de Chardin Center** in the Democratic Republic of the Congo has just sent us an update. It is about to receive legal status from the Ministry of Justice as a nonprofit association, and is no longer operating solely in Djuma (Kwilu Province), but is setting up operations about 30 km from the capital, Kinshasa, on a 25-hectare plot of land. The coordinator is Father Ghislain Tshikendwa Matadi, S.J., assisted by a team of four people. The Center is set to carry out a wide range of activities: an orphanage, literacy programs and an agricultural business incubator, in addition to a publishing house that has released a number of Father Tshikendwa's works, including his latest book on Job, which is available on Amazon. Laval (Canada) reminds us of Laval (France), where Pierre Teilhard spent his first year at the juvenate (after the novitiate) and where he took his first vows on March 25, 1901, just before his 20th birthday. Here is an excerpt from the letter he wrote to his parents that day:

At last I am a Jesuit: I don't have time to write you a long letter today, but I want to tell you how happy I am to finally belong entirely to the Sacred Heart through the Blessed Virgin. If only you knew how happy I am to have finally committed myself completely, and forever, to the Society, especially at a time when it is being persecuted. I prayed fervently for all of you today, and surely Our Lord will never forget all that you have done to support my vocation. But please keep praying that I may live up to what the good Lord asks of me.*

*1901 was the year of the exception laws, and Émile Combes's rise to power marked the height of anticlericalism in France. The Jesuits then withdrew to England and the Channel Islands.
